The Neptun is the system in which all the information concerning your studies and matters related are administrated. The easiest way to login is through the CAO (the body at the university responsible for the Neptun data) webpage at kth.bme.hu/en. We publish all sorts of information on this website to help you understand the Neptun and the processes and tasks connected.
